The Rav Singer Chevra Mishnayos proudly invites the Lower East Side community to participate in a special Siyum on Seder Zeroim, the first Order of the Mishna, on Sunday, January 15th at 8 PM. The Bialystoker inaugurated the Chevra Mishnayos last year on the yohrzeit of the late Rav Yitzchok Aharon Singer zt"l, and will be finishing Seder Zeroim in conjunction with his fifth yohrzeit. Rav Singer devoted more than forty years of his life to spreading the light of Torah in the Lower East Side; this evening of Torah dedicated to his memory reminds us that "tzaddikim are deemed alive even after their passing." We invite all to join us in paying tribute to this giant of Torah and his brilliant legacy of illumination which still lights our collective paths.
